How do I know if a power outlet is not working?

Sounds too simple, but you'd kick yourself if you find it only after hours of troubleshooting everything else. Loose connection at outlet or previous device: Check behind the non-working outlet first. Then check the nearest devices (other outlets or switches) to that outlet.

Check appliances for any signs of damage following a power outage - unusual noises, strange smells (burning), or malfunctioning components. If you detect any anomalies, unplug the appliance immediately and contact a qualified appliance repair technician.
