What is the telecommunications industry like in the DRC?

The telecommunications industry has not yet reached all potential consumers and has room to grow. Mobile telephones have a 44 percent penetration rate; internet penetration is approximately 3 percent of the total population. The DRC has not yet reached 5G and is still developing its 3G/4G network.

Who manages telecommunications & Internet policies in DRC?

The telecommunications and Internet policies are all being managed by the DRC ministry of telecommunication called "Societe Congolaise des Postes et Telecommunications". The ministry is responsible for all digital communication tools (including radio, television, fixed and mobile telephones, and the Internet.

How much money does the DRC need to maintain its network infrastructures?
